The Reggio Approach combined with Jewish values-based learning offers a unique and advanced method of education that stimulates thinking, fosters relationships and promotes a child's sense of identity.

In its third year, SDJA's High School Science and Technology Research Program achieved amazing results. Three students participating in the cutting edge, two-year program received the Sweepstakes Award (top award available) at the Greater San Diego Science and Engineering Fair. They also placed at the Intel International Science and Engineering Fair, which is considered the foremost high school science competition in the world. Seven million students worldwide compete for a place at Intel and only 1,600 are selected. The SDJA students placed in the top 25%, putting them in the top 0.0006% of competitors worldwide.



From its Reggio inspired, Jewishly infused preschool to its High School Science and Technology Research Program, SDJA offers many pathways of inspiration for students. These programs enhance the educational experience for SDJA students and prepare them for the most challenging course of all - LIFE.
